INFORMATION CLAUSE

Pursuant to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27/04/2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data: we would like to inform you that:

- and International Relations International Relations Office, hereinafter referred to as the Administrator.

- 3. Your personal data will be processed in order to carry out the recruitment process of students for study trips abroad under the ERASMUS+ (SM) program.
- 4. The legal basis for the processing of your data is: Act Law on Higher Education and Science of July 20, 2018. and Regulations for trips under the ERASMUS+ program in the 2021-2027 edition introduced by Resolution No. 17/2022 of the Senate of the Poznan University of Medical Sciences on February 16, 2022.
- 5. The Administrator does not disclose your personal data to any recipients, except for cases where such an obligation results from the provisions of generally applicable law.
- 6. The administrator will store your personal data for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of processing, i.e. 5 years from the date of receipt of the application.
- 7. In cases, under the terms and in the manner specified in applicable regulations, you have the right to request: access to the data content and rectification, deletion of data, restriction of processing, objection to processing, transfer of data and to withdraw consent, if it has been granted.
- 8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00-163 Warszawa if you suspect that personal data are being processed by the Administrator in violation of the law;
- 9. Your personal data is not subject to automated decision-making, including profiling, referred to in Art. 4 point 4) GDPR.
